






IT UPDATE

During the session, Sophia discussed the types of students most inclined to complete a full-time degree overseas and what factors this demographic prioritises when seeking a university. She elaborated on the importance of relationship building through the application and admissions process with students and the stakeholders that influence their decision making.

Taggart discussed what he described as "creepy cool" marketing techniques. He emphasised the importance of the "red thread" or consistent story that is present and clear in all marketing content.

This webinar was delivered to UK clients with in-country representation in the US.

It means:


- You'll be able to book travel via empanelled vendors and won't have to worry about invoicing

VINITA DESAI - SENIOR RECRUITMENT ADVISOR FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND, SOUTH ASIA

My role as a Senior Recruitment Advisor for the University of Auckland involves planning and supporting recruitment events with agent partners, student engagement, institutional events, exploring new markets and collaborating with institutions for partnership opportunities and TNE for students across South Asia.

As New Zealand is located in the southern hemisphere of the globe time zone wise it's ahead of India by almost 7.5 hours. My day typically begins at 7.30 am IST for meetings and calls with colleagues at the university. Calls are inclusive of recruitment and market updates, planning, weekly meetings and any other areas of concern. The role demands a lot of multitasking; so, the first quarter of the day is spent interacting with colleagues from NZ and by early afternoon IST, I begin my interaction with agents/students/counselors or other institutional partners addressing their queries and concerns.



I spend a lot of my time on emails and calls with our stakeholders. I also organise Zoom sessions with students or parents to walk them through our programmes or talk about the university in general. I conduct virtual training sessions for agents and counselors to update them on our programmes, scholarships or sometimes just a friendly catchup to gather some market intel. Thanks to the virtual world, we also have regular meetings with several institutional partners like Education New Zealand where all 8 NZ universities, along with team ENZ, discuss and plan strategies to promote NZ and our brands.

We work around the clock and travel or work most weekends. I spend almost half the month traveling to our key markets and sometimes explore newer markets to get a better idea of the opportunities that they present. My travel includes agent visits, high school fairs, career fairs organised by educational institutions and of course events and fairs organised by our agent partners. I meet a lot of students and their parents at these events and spend time discussing the university programmes, career opportunities, scholarships and sometimes just listen to their aspirations and provide them appropriate guidance.

Travel is hectic for sure! We have back-to-back flights or long road journeys to attend events especially during the peak months before our Jan/Feb and July August intakes. The fun part of

travel is that we have colleagues traveling from different universities and airports and events are places where we often bump into many of them. Traveling and meeting colleagues, gaining different perspectives from them and understanding different markets and destination trends are important to my role and I feel that these experiences enrich me. I am often invited to educational institutes to talk to students about career opportunities in NZ and about the university.

I take up exploring new markets at times when we are not very busy with agent events and collaborate with other agents and institutions for school events or institutional visits where we address students directly and talk about our university and the programmes. This is a great brand awareness exercise as we are promoting New Zealand as a destination of choice and waving the university flag as proudly as we can.





I plan my strategies for the year in a way that I ensure I support both agent-based recruitment events and participate in other institutional events for encouraging direct applicants. I have also been engaging in planning and providing support and advice to various faculties to explore partnerships with institutions in India. I ensure I accompany delegates to some of these institutions wherever possible. Planning engagement activities for university delegations and involving in collaborations and internationalisation of education is an integral part of my role.

So as you can see, there is never a dull moment in the life of an ICR.

ALYCE MYERS (DURHAM UNIVERSITY) AND MUBARIK IBRAHIM (UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHAMPTON) AT BEST OF U



Mubarik is an International Officer supporting the University of Southampton. Alyce is an International Officer supporting Durham University. Mubarik and Alyce recently attended the Best of U tour with three other UK-based universities, including York - another Acumen partner!

Katie: What cities did you visit on the Best of U tour?

Mubarik: We visited Minneapolis, Milwaukee, Chicago, and Indianapolis. Then the group continued on to Charlotte, Durham, and Raleigh, North Carolina.

Katie: I'll ask this to each of you - what was your biggest takeaway from being on the tour?

Alyce: For me, it was just meeting everyone in person for the first time, it was just really nice to connect with everyone. I'd heard stories about past Best of U events and how great the group is, so it was nice to put faces to names. We did one virtual meeting with everyone before the trip but it was great to meet everyone in person.

Mubarik: For me, it was actually traveling with the group. I've met them previously but never traveled around with them. So it was good to see them and build connections. I also learned more about all the different things that other universities are doing to recruit in the states - that was pretty cool.

Katie: For those who aren't familiar with Best of U can you give us an overview of the tour? Who are you meeting with and what are the goals?

Alyce: The tour includes a lot of counselor lunches.

So if you're in a city for breakfast or around lunch time, you'll meet with counselors from top schools in that area. This is a time to have an informal chat about your institutions and about studying in the UK. Then during the evening time is when one of the schools will host the Best of U event in the city. At each event we talk about studying in the UK, the UCAS system, and finances. Then it goes into a five minute presentation with each university. At the very end, there's time for discussion and similar to a college fair style – students and parents can walk up to your table, ask questions and you can give them information.

Mubarik: It's a traveling circus in a way. Like one night only: Best of U are in town. I think inviting counselors to lunch or breakfast is a good way of networking. You're not in their office, you're not in a school. You're sitting down at a table across from each other having honest conversations about higher education in the UK or just life in general and you're building a solid relationship.

Katie: What do you both think the benefits are of doing this type of event with other university participation?

Mubarik: I think it's appealing to the schools to have five top UK universities coming to visit you. I think for them they're like, we can kill five birds with one stone. For us, it keeps the cost down and we share the planning. We all have different counselors we have worked with, when we put them together you suddenly have a large counselor network that you can invite.

Alyce: You get to reach more counselors and more students than you would alone. It's after school, students don't have class conflicts, parents can come and I think it makes it more of an incentive at that point.

Katie: My final question, you both have mentioned that you love trying new food when traveling so I will ask, best meal of the trip?

Alyce: Mushroom risotto from a restaurant in Milwaukee. That was fantastic!

Mubarik: Harry and Izzy's in Indianapolis. It had kind of a mix of everything, but I had toasted ravioli. We also had a chocolate chip bread pudding. Amazing to say the least.


